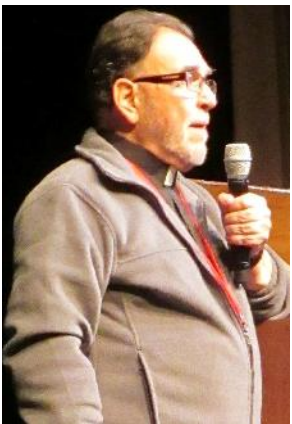

Then they turned toward the audience and prayed for all Christian brothers and sisters everywhere who believe in the teachings of Jesus and claim him as their Lord and Savior, that God would heal our differences and unite us in love as one body of Christ. At Pentecost they were all united in one accord. We have the Holy Spirit to the degree that we are in unity with one another. In John 17 Jesus prays that we have the same oneness as the Holy Trinity has - that kind of love. At this time there are so many churches—so many doctrines. The holy Spirit brings unity. The Holy Spirit will break down those barriers that separate us. Those divisions come from man, not God. Bishops Nevares and Olmstead have be-

Cardinal Paul Joseph Cordes and Auxiliary Bishop Eduardo Nevares Spoke to Diocesan Ministry Leaders About the New Evangelization

Ministry leaders met at St. Paul Parish in Phoenix on December 3rd to learn more about the New Evangelization in the Catholic Church. Cardinal Cordes told us the New Evangelization calls not just the priests, but also all lay Catholics to spread the gospel to others. We must be informed in our faith and witnesses of Jesus Christ. We must not leave it to others, but we, ourselves

must be evangelists. The church as a society must be a witness. In the old model before Vatican II the priest was active but the people were not. The priest did everything. Now we are all expected to be active, working together with the priests, sharing our personal experience of what it is to be part of the church today. In the old model we just listened. In the new model we participate in spreading the gospel and sharing Jesus with others. In the new model we are all active, the whole church participates in evangelization. The whole community is active. It doesn't mean we don't need the priests. We have a new responsibility to be brother and leader along with our priests. The Holy Spirit is renewing the Church to live and proclaim the gospel, to proclaim God as a person. We have to speak about God. Jesus spoke constantly of the reality of his Father.

Father Bruno emphasized in his homily that whatever healing we receive it is what's best for us. Healing comes. It doesn't matter if you're sick or not. The greatest gift of all is spiritual healing in our soul, in our relationship with

God. Healing is a sweet song for God. God will always give us healing. He wants us to enjoy the gift of life, but not



away from Him. The Holy Spirit in us wants us to have what is of God, and remove from us that which is not of God.

Father Dan spoke to us about having solid roots, knowledge about our faith. We study. We want to be strong trees with good strong roots. We do what we can to receive whatever we can handle. We say "yes Father, I am here to do your will".
